EYE CONTACT:

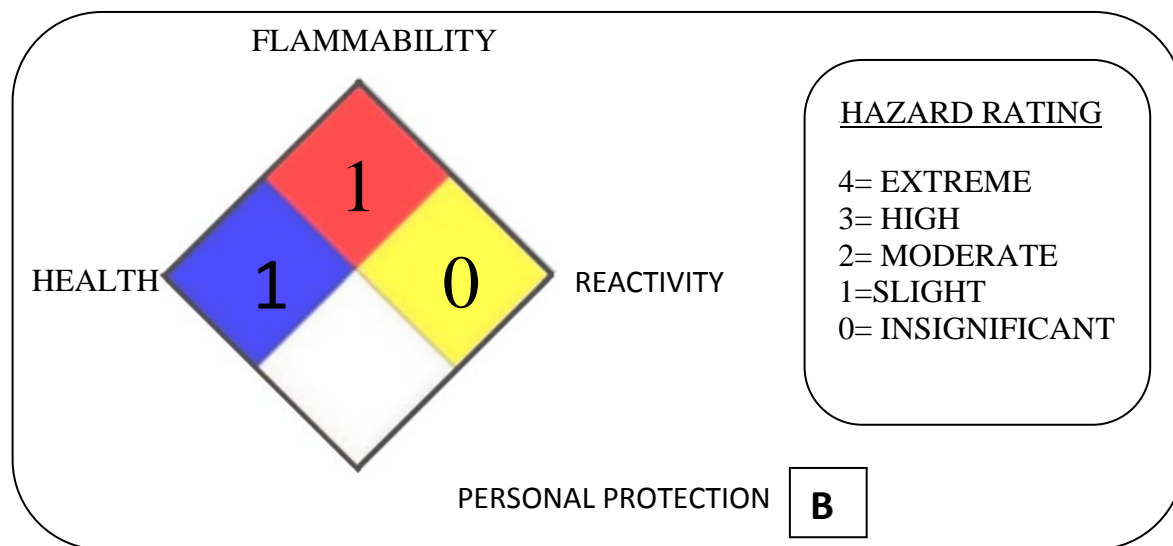
